- You will support your client to design a delicious, compelling new game, choose a field of play and identify new roles for themselves and others.
- You will discover a new state from which your clients can operate, and identify simple moves to sustain their learning.
- You will practice with your colleagues:
  - the sustainable 'state' required to win the new game
  - the conversations which will keep your client and others in their newly designed roles
  - the actions you will take and the actions your client will no longer take as they complete their undesired game
  - the "shape" which will enable your client to generate and sustain the 'body' of the new game.
